

TAKING PHOTOS!

Why can't I take pictures?

Taking photos or video at a protest puts everyone at risk. Capturing moments that people may not want filmed, can put people in real danger, because any footage can lead to arrests, jail time and harsh penalties.

What can I film?

For everyones safety and comfort, put cameras and phones away. If you insist on documenting the protest and there is a police presence, film them and their identification numbers (so we can hold police accountable), film yourself after you've left the demonstration, or come back the next day and film any messages that were written! Remember, do not record protesters faces, shoes, backs, etc.

Do you have consent?

Always ask for consent before you take a picture or video of ANYONE (except cops). Whether you are at a demonstration or at the zoo, not everyone wants to be documented and its important that we show each other mutual respect. Only record IF you have gotten consent from everyone in view.
